



PUBLIC SAFETY MESSAGE: INFORMATION RELATING TO COVID-19

TRAVELLERS RETURNING TO AUSTRALIA SELF ISOLATE OR FACE \$1000 FINE

The Public Health (COVID-19 Quarantine) Order 2020 is presently in force in New South Wales. Any person who arrives in New South Wales from another country must isolate themselves for a quarantine period of **14 days**.

Go directly to your house or hotel and self quarantine for 14 days. You must not leave your house or hotel!

Additionally, Mass Gathering and Closure Directions are now in order in New South Wales. Familiarise yourself with Directions presently in order and abide by them as a matter of urgency.

It is an offence for a person to fail to comply with the Health Minister's Public Health (COVID-19 Quarantine) Order 2020 (\$11,000 and/or 6 months imprisonment). Police can also issue a **\$1,000 on the spot fine**.



While in self-isolation you should monitor yourself for COVID-19 symptoms. If symptoms develop, report them to Healthdirect on **1800 022 222** or, if it is an emergency, call an Ambulance and tell them you are in home-isolation.
